City Council Minutes of Meeting June 14, 2012 6:30 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Farmington met on June 14, 2012 at Long Memorial Hall, 110 West Columbia Street, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Dennis Smith.
