City Counselor, Scott Reid, was present.




Greg Beavers, City Administrator, explained the application for the subdivision.

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
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Mayor Forsythe stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:

An Amendment to Title IV: Land Use, Chapter 405: Zoning Regulations, Article VI: Supplementary Regulations, Section 405.040 and Section 405.230, a land use known as "Accessory Building And Structures, Fences" and enacting certain regulations pertaining thereto.

Greg Beavers, City Administrator, explained that the Planning & Zoning Committee felt that the two-foot separation required between the property line of the adjacent property line and a fence is not necessary.


