Tim Porter, Director of Development Services, explained that an error was discovered in the labeling of zoning OP-1. He explained the table was incorrectly labeled OP-2.



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Mayor Forsythe stated that a Public Hearing is being held to gain input regarding:

An application for a Final Record Plat at 806 W Columbia Street (Case FRP-17-017). The property is currently zoned as "R-3" Single-Family Residential District. Submitted by the City of Farmington on behalf of Chris and Alison Sprung.

Tim Porter, Director of Development Services, explained that this is a property owned by the Sprungs that will be used to widen the sidewalk to increase safety in that area. He explained the only cost to the City will be for a fence on the property line along the sidewalk.


