ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

V. Pegram motioned to approve the February 11, 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by C. Morrison. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Request to make Bent Creek Drive a Public street – The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Basketball Goals in the Street – The Committee discussed the issue. L. Lacy requested that C. Morrison bring up to City Council, but no further action was taken.

The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
3. Fleming & Walter Sidewalk – L. Lacy presented a cost estimate for the project. V. Pegram motioned to proceed and forward to City Council with a favorable recommendation, with a target of completing the project before the start of the 2022 school year. The motion was seconded by C. Morrison. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.
4. 2021 Curb & Gutter and Concrete Bids – The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
5. 2021 Asphalt Bids - The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
6. 2021 Excavation and Hauling Bids - The Committee discussed the issue but no action was taken.
7. Weber Road Improvements – The Committee discussed the issue. H. Peterson motioned to have parking blocks added to the eight stalls that abut Maple Valley Drive at the corner of Maple

Valley Drive and Weber Road. The motion was seconded by V. Pegram. The Committee voted unanimously in favor of this motion.


8. Other Items of Interest - None
