Solid Waste Collection, Transporting, Processing, Or Disposing



1. No license shall be issued until and unless the applicant therefor, in addition to all other requirements set forth, shall file and maintain with the City Council evidence of a satisfactory public liability insurance policy, covering all operations of such applicant pertaining to such business and all vehicles to be operated in the conduct thereof, in the amount of not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for each person injured or killed, and in the amount of not less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) in the event of injury or death of two (2) or more persons in any single accident, and in the amount of not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for damage to property.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

All transportation vehicles shall be maintained in a safe, clean and sanitary condition and shall be so constructed, maintained and operated as to prevent spillage of solid waste therefrom. All vehicles to be used for transportation of solid waste shall be constructed with watertight bodies and with covers which shall be an integral part of the vehicle or shall be a separate cover of suitable material with fasteners designed to secure all sides of the cover to the vehicle and shall be secured whenever the vehicle is transporting solid waste or as an alternate, the entire bodies thereof shall be enclosed with only loading hoppers exposed. No solid waste shall be transported in the loading hoppers.

No vehicle used for the purpose of collecting or transporting solid wastes shall be parked for a period of more than one (1) hour, either in the day or at night, upon any street or highway within the limits of this City.

In order to ensure compliance with the laws of this State, this Chapter and the rules and regulations authorized herein, the City Council is authorized to designate an inspector to inspect all phases of solid waste management within the City. No inspection shall be made in any residential unit unless authorized by the occupant, upon presentation of proper credentials, or by due process of law. In all instances where inspections reveal violation of this Chapter, the rules and regulations authorized herein for the storage, collection, transportation, processing or disposal of solid waste or the laws of the State, the City Council or its designated agent shall issue notice for each such violation stating therein the violation found, the time and date and the corrective measure to be taken, together with the time in which any such corrections shall be made.
