Registration Dates/Deadlines: Registration begins on April 2, 2018 at 8:00 AM. There are limited spots in each week of camp. Farmington Fort Fun Day Camps require pre-registration. Participants must register for camp one week prior to the start date. Late fees will be assessed for those that register past 11:59 pm on the previous Monday. Late registration will only be allowed at the discretion of the Assistant Recreation Coordinator.

Camper information: Camper information questions must be completed at the time of registration. For the safety of the campers, it is important that questions are answered in full each time a new registration is entered.

Fees: All fees are required at the time of registration. In order to keep affordable camp pricing, we will not hold reservations. Fees are calculated per week and will not be pro-rated. We accept cash, check, Visa, Master Card, American Express and Discover.



Lunch: Each child should bring a non perishable lunch each day. Those with peanut allergies will have lunch at a table designated as "peanut free". Please include morning and afternoon snack and a refillable water bottle for each day.

Sign In/Out: Each child will be signed in and out of camp each day. Parents or Guardians will be asked for a government issued ID each day prior to the child being released. Parents may add additional individuals to their child's pick up list.

Field Trips: will be held on Wednesdays unless otherwise specified in the weekly camp newsletter. Drop off on field trip days will be at the Braxton/Hall Pavilion in Engler Park. Children will be required to wear their Fort Fun Day Camp t-shirt on field trips.

Water Park: Each Friday campers will be dropped off at the Civic Center's Gymnasium. Each child will be administered a 25 yard, any stroke, swim test to qualify them as a "swimmer" or "non-swimmer". Non-Swimmers will be allowed to use the splash pad and the water play structure. All other water park policies and procedures apply.

Sunscreen: Counselors are not permitted to apply lotion sunscreen to your child however; counselors will supervise spray on sunscreen and will remind your camper frequently throughout the day.

Medication: Medication in its original packaging/container will be administered by the Day Camp Director. Campers will not be allowed to hold medication through the day. Medication will be kept safe by the Camp Director and administered by the director at the designated time and logged after each use.

Refund/Transfer Policy

Refunds are available under the following policy:

1. A full refund will be made to all registrants when a program is cancelled.
2. A pro-rated refund will be made to any registrant who cancels due to a health reason after a confirmation has been received from their health care provider. If requesting a refund due to illness, a written request, accompanied by the physician's statement, must be received by The Civic Center no later than 7 days after seeking medical treatment.
3. A camp refund request will be granted if the written cancellation is received at least one week prior to the start of camp.
4. Camp registration transfers will be honored if the transfer request is received within 6 days prior to the start date of that camp.
