Farmington Parks and Recreation Portable Floor Refinishing**

The City of Farmington reserves the right to reject any proposal that takes exception to these conditions. The City also reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals and to select from any or all remaining proposals, the proposal it believes to be the best for the City.

1.00 SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL

Sealed proposals along with vendor proposal form can be submitted to the Parks and Recreation Director, Farmington Civic Center – 2 Black Knight Drive, Farmington, Missouri, 63640. Each proposal must be clearly marked as a proposal for Portable Floor Refinishing

The deadline for proposals is 10:00 a.m., June 1, 2018. No proposal will be accepted after the deadline for submission of proposals, regardless of the reason for such lateness, and will be returned to sender unopened.

2.00 QUESTIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS

3.00 MODIFICATIONS TO PROPOSALS

Proposals may be withdrawn or modified in writing prior to the proposal submission deadline. All changes and/or additions to this request for proposals will be made in the form of a written addendum.

5.00 REQUESTED SERVICES

Request is for listed services on a 1996 Horner 60' x 110' portable floor. Assess any

structural damage and cosmetic issue and make necessary repairs and adjustments to the panels as needed. Assemble floor, sand to bare wood, apply two coats of seal, paint and finish with two coats of oil modified urethane finish. Two, two color logos and painted border shall be included in pricing. Price shall include shipping from Farmington, Missouri to successful bidder's facility and back. City staff will package and load floor for shipment. Pricing should be presented as a "not to exceed" price.
